• 1 (3-oz.) box strawberry Jell-O

Frosting

- 1 1/2 cups heavy cream
- 1 (8-oz.) block cream cheese, room temperature
- 2/3 cup confectioners' sugar
- 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- 1/8 tsp. kosher salt

Topping

- 24 vanilla sandwich cookies, such as Golden Oreos
- 4 Tbsp. (1/2 stick) unsalted butter, melted
- 1 (3-oz.) box strawberry Jell-O
- Fresh strawberries, halved lengthwise

Directions:

Cake

- Preheat oven to 350°. Grease a 13"-x-9" baking pan with cooking spray.
 Prepare cake according to package directions.
- Pour batter into prepared pan. Bake cake until a tester inserted into the center comes out clean, 20 to 25 minutes. Let cool.
- Using a bamboo skewer or chopstick, poke holes all over cake, making sure not to go through to the bottom and spacing 1/2" to 1" apart.
- In a small saucepan, bring 1/2 cup water to a boil. Add Jell-O powder; whisk until dissolved. Remove from heat and whisk in 1/2 cup cold water.
- Pour gelatin mixture evenly over holes on cake. Cover and refrigerate at least 2 hours or up to overnight.

Frosting

- In a large bowl, using a handheld mixer, beat cream on medium-high speed until stiff peaks form.
- In another large bowl, using handheld mixer, beat cream cheese on mediumhigh speed until smooth and fluffy.
 Add confectioners' sugar and beat until smooth, then add in vanilla and salt.
 Fold in whipped cream until just combined.
- Spread frosting over top of cake; reserve remaining frosting for topping (optional).

Deadlines help keep your momentum going.


